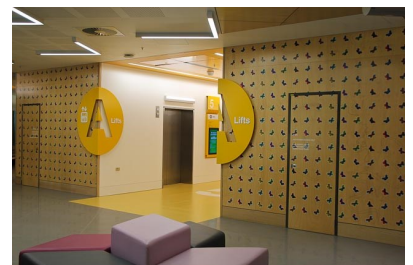
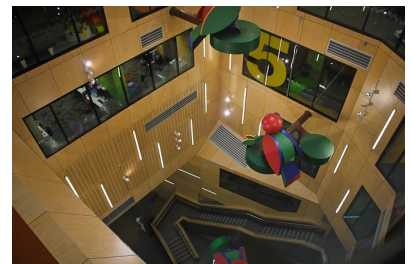


The hospital features an atrium style interior with plywood walls and ceilings featured throughout every floor. With a clear focus on families, the design incorporates the use of bright colours, space, eccentric shapes and has a huge focus on environmentally sustainable design principles, including reducing emissions. The coating used had to comply with QLD Government Building and Safety Regulations and meet the Green Building Council of Australia's guidelines in regard to VOC emissions.

During the specification phase of the project, Peter Glancy and Grant Langley from Qld's Mirotone branch were instrumental in providing support to the three contractors who were involved in the huge task of coating part of this 75,000m² building. (Contractors: Matt Goodall from Prolacquer, Keith Cusac from Paintzone and Warren Beattie French Polishing)

Due to the sheer size of the project, these three local paint contractors were entrusted with coating the plywood board interior of the building.
